

#### **CHILDREN OF DIVORCE**

1-The father is no longer regared as a peripheral parent and the raising of children isn't any more the mother's primary concern. The view of life with father is changing because of economic necessity. A growing number of men are rejecting the idea that father cannot take responsibility of a baby after divorce. The reason is simple; Many Americans face both the pleasures and pains of raising the children and most of them enjoy this new role.

**2**-According to a 1980 census more than one million children are now raised exclusively by their fathers. This new role as illustrated by films such as « Kramer VS Kramer » is discouraging the idea that mother always knows best.

**3-**David Thomas was a single father who has recently been on the dole. He divorced because his wife was no longer loveable. To make matters worse, she refused to take her two - year - old Henry in custody. David was depressed but this was no obstacle to his raising of Henry. He gave him all affection and assumed the role of a father as well as mother to the extent that Henry's mother's presence was no more a necessity.

4-And yet the hidden part of the iceberg is bigger. What is the aftermath? Educators and teachers have realized that children of divorce take out their frustration and anger in school becoming trouble makers. In fact, this is the category which achieves less. They are absent more and create disciplinary problems. They are depressed and often appear very bored with no motivation.

5-The greatest problem with single parents is that they assume a sole responsibility. The children are forced to grow up too fast, to behave as adults. Sometimes a boy is spoiled during his mother's custody and may learn feminine rather than masculine play patterns.
