Indefinite Articles

- ✤ The indefinite articles are: a and an.
 - We use **a** before a consonant-sound.
 - We use **an** before a vowel-sound.
- The difference depends on the sound of the vowels and consonants, not the spelling.

Examples:

- \checkmark a teacher
- ✓ a peach
- ✓ **a** woman
- ✓ a house
- ✓ a man
- \checkmark a useful book
- \checkmark a university
- ✓ **a** European
- ✓ a house
- ✓ an English teacher
- ✓ an orange
- ✓ an old woman
- ✓ an hour
- ✓ an honest man
- ✓ an heir
- ✓ an honour
- ✓ an Irish person

Don't put a or an before uncountable nouns:

- ✓ I don't like milk.
- ✓ Silence is golden.
- ✓ We're having soup for lunch.
